- COVID-19 and state level issues with IDES, does not anticipate buildings open until July, Plexiglas and
 other measures may be taken. Temp checks called cost-prohibitive, appointments may be needed in the
 long term, discussions on additional documentation may be needed and flexibility discussions to continue
 working from home
 - 25k in tech spent to allow work from home, including cell phones and laptops
- Rebuild IL, grant money on table for possible capital improvements- possibly Reachout
- Will be switching some accounts from BOS to Liberty bank
- Dave Bellis, 2nd John Birch
- Concerns were raised about changing bank relationships due to appearance of impropriety
- Other options for not incurring cell costs were discussed
- Lease options were discussed as well as other locations, but Workforce Dept. would need to remain in building

 - New DHS grant we are pursuing \$435k+

- Community Development (CD) /Revolving Loan Fund (RLF) –Charles Bell
 - Chad Frederick in office/ working from home
 - Working with EDA to get back in good graces so that we can apply for new years grant
- Need to work on including other 3 counties, but there are bylaw issues
 - Land bank grant- feasibility study is complete, looks feasible City of Quincy as over 1k properties that might qualify
- Would allow for improvements to many properties
- Will explore with other counties
- Could be self-sustaining within 2-3 years
 - Business loan program
- Adams County- 2 loans, City of Quincy has made 40, TRRC has made 4 \$10k each
- Pending loan application for Pike county
- TRRC has only allocated \$100k
 - One RLF loan pending but on hold due to COVID
